## NATIVE PONIES

Judging 11 – 12.30 pm

Mountain & Moorland

Ponies should be shown in their natural state (e.g. NO plaited manes or tails).

Categories 14-17 Shown in Hand

- 14 REGISTERED LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY, MARE or GELDING to be shown in hand. 4 years old or over. Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Highland and Welsh Section C&D.
- 15 REGISTERED LARGE MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY, MARE or GELDING to be shown in hand. 3 years & under. Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Highland and Welsh Section C&D.
- 16 REGISTERED SMALL MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY, MARE or GELDING to be shown in hand. 4 years old or over, Dartmoor or Exmoor, Registered Welsh Section A&B.
- 17 REGISTERED SMALL MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND PONY, MARE or GELDING to be shown in hand. 3 years & under. Dartmoor or Exmoor, Welsh Section A&B.
